This year's Festival programme highlights music from Hungary, Poland, Scandinavia and Spain, some of it inspired by local and gypsy cultures.

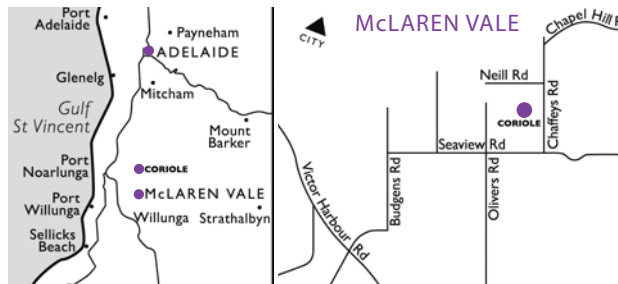
